

2024 Middle School/Junior High All State Choir Audition & Application Info

TCDA is thrilled to begin auditions for the 2024 MS/JH All State Choir under the direction of Coty Raven Morris. Last summer, over 900 students from across the state applied to take part. We hope Texas' music educators can help even more students work toward this opportunity for Summer 2024. This document contains important information regarding the audition process. Please review it carefully.

General Audition Info

Directors must be current TCDA members to submit their students. Each director may submit as many singers as they like. Auditions are open to students who are currently in 7th or 8th grade. 6th graders whose voices have already transitioned to Tenor or Bass are also eligible to audition.

Auditions will consist of three separate mp3 audio files. One will be a recording of the singer performing *My Country Tis'* of Thee and the other two will be of the singer performing scales. Specific details can be found on pages 3 and 4. Recordings that don't follow all audition guidelines are subject to disqualification.

Directors will need to submit their students' audio auditions through the TCDA website. Directors have the ability to submit their students' audition fee payments, but the students' families have the ability to pay directly as well.

Expenses and Making Payments

The fees All State Choir members pay help us cover the costs of hiring our guest clinician and accompanist. Additionally, it pays for each member to receive their sheet music, a tote bag, water bottle, video and audio recordings of the concert, and a t-shirt that will be worn during their performance. All fees are non-refundable. Expenses include:

Audition fee - \$20
Registration fee - \$120
Hotel/ Food/Transportation - arranged and paid for by participant's family

The audition and registration fees may be paid online, by check, or by money order. If you prefer to pay by check or money order, please make your payment out to TCDA and include your child's full name in the memo line. Mail to:



How and What to Record

The rules to record auditions are listed on the next two pages. Please follow all steps carefully. Failure to do so can result in the disqualification of a student's application. "File 1 - My Country Tis of Thee"

- 1. The student will perform My Country 'Tis of Thee without accompaniment.
- 2. Soprano 1s will sing in the key of A (A4 starting pitch); Soprano 2s will sing in the key of G (G4 starting pitch; Altos will sing in the key of D (D4 starting pitch); Tenor 1s will sing in the key of A (A3 starting pitch), Tenor 2s will sing in the key of F (F3) and Basses will sing in the key of D (D3 starting pitch).
- 3. There can be no identifying information in the recording—the student's name, age, director, school, etc cannot be stated. No voice other than the child's should be present.
- 4. The <u>starting pitch must be played</u> in the recording before the student begins singing. Please make sure there are no voices heard other than the students.



"File 2 - Ascending Pattern"

- 1. The student will sing the following rising pattern without accompaniment. Make sure your singer performs the one assigned to their voice part.
- 2. They must follow the pitch and tempo shown in the music.
- 3. They can sing it on either solfege or a neutral syllable of their choice.
- 4. The starting pitch must be played at the beginning of the recording. No other pitches can be given. The student's voice must be the only one heard.

"File 3 - Descending Pattern"

- 1. The student will sing the following falling pattern without accompaniment. Make sure your singer performs the one assigned to their voice part.
- 2. They must follow the pitch and tempo shown in the music.
- 3. They can sing it on either solfege or a neutral syllable of their choice.

4. The starting pitch must be played at the beginning of the recording. No other pitches can be given. The student's voice must be the only one heard.

How to Upload Audition Files

To submit auditions, you will need an account established with OpusEvent. The email that you use to create your OpusEvent account should be the same email that you use for your TCDA account. You may already have an account if you submitted auditions for TCDA last year or if you submit auditions for ACDA or NfAME. This can be found at: https://audition.opusevent.com/

You will be directed to upload three files. They need to be titled and ordered like the example below:

- 1. File 1 My Country Tis of Thee
- 2. File 2 Ascending Pattern
- 3. File 3 Descending Pattern

Remember, you may pay the \$20 audition fee through OpusEvent as well. Whether you pay online or by check/money order, audition fees must be paid by January 15.
